**ORDINANCE NO. 11- 2  
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE POSITION  
OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR**

**WHEREAS**, in conjunction with the recodification project undertaken by the Borough officials, review of the Borough's body of legislation has uncovered that certain subjects pertaining to the administration of Borough Government have not previously been adopted; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body has determined that legislation pertaining to the position of Emergency Management Coordinator of the Borough is desired for inclusion in the new Code;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Governing Body of the Borough of Westwood as follows:

Section 1. The following provisions pertaining to the position of Emergency Management Coordinator of the Borough shall be included in the new Code of the Borough of Westwood as Article XV, Emergency Management Coordinator, of Chapter 40, Officers and Employees:

ARTICLE XV  
**Emergency Management Coordinator**

**§ 40-49. Creation of position; appointment; term.**

There is hereby established the office of Emergency Management Coordinator, pursuant to the provisions of executive orders and state statute. The Emergency Management Coordinator shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of the Borough Council, for a term of three years.

**§ 40-50. Duties.**

The duties and authority of the Emergency Management Coordinator shall be governed by executive order and state statute.

**§ 40-51. Compensation.**

The Emergency Management Coordinator shall receive compensation as provided in the current Salary Ordinance.

Section 2. Any Ordinance or a part thereof which is inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and is, hereby amended.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
