ORDINANCE NO. 15-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WESTWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR SIGNS/BARRICADES AND CONES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND APPROPRIATING \$5,000 FROM AVAILABLE SURPLUS IN THE BOROUGH'S CAPITAL TRUST FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WESTWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The total amount of \$5,000 is hereby appropriated by the Borough of Westwood, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") which amount is comprised of surplus funds of the Borough's Capital Fund for signage/cones and barricades for the Borough's Department of Public Works and related expenses, including all things necessary therefore or incidental thereto.

Section 2. The capital budget or temporary capital budget (as applicable) of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or amended temporary capital budget (as applicable) and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by Law.

The foregoing ordinance is hereby approved.
