Ordinance 15-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 249 PEDDLING AND SOLICITING TO INCLUDE ROADWAY CHARITABLE SOLICITATION

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Westwood that Chapter 249-17 is hereby created:

§249-17 Roadway Charitable Solicitation

Charitable organizations that desire to conduct roadway solicitation must first make application to the Borough Clerk's office. Authorized locations are Westwood/Washington Avenues at Broadway, Five Corners, Jefferson Avenue at Broadway, First Avenue at Park. Dates are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. Organizations are required to abide by the Westwood Police Department's current Road Side Fund Raising Do's and Don'ts. Tokens or receipts shall be provided to donors to display on the automobile dashboard in order to allow drivers to demonstrate prior donation that day.

The County of Bergen has also adopted an ordinance governing roadway charitable solicitation. Municipal approval alone is not sufficient. A copy of the County ordinance is available from the Borough Clerk. Organizations may be required to produce copies of county and municipal approval during a roadway solicitation upon request by the Westwood Police Department.

If any section, subsection, part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
