**Ordinance #15-5
An Ordinance to Amend Chapter 375-20 Vehicles and Traffic,
Resident Sticker Zones**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Westwood that Chapter 375-20 Resident Sticker Zones is hereby amended as follows:

375-20 Resident Sticker Zones

A. The following streets or parts of streets are hereby designated as resident sticker zones. No person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, public holidays excepted, unless the vehicle has displayed in the left rear window a valid and current resident sticker.

Street	Side	Location
Fourth Avenue	East	From Park Avenue to Elm Street
Memorial Drive	West	From Third Avenue to Park Avenue
Park Avenue	North	From First Avenue to Memorial Drive
Park Avenue	North	From a point 185 feet west of the westerly curblines of Memorial Drive, west to Third Avenue
Second Avenue	East	From a point 60 feet south of Park Avenue, south to a point 145 feet north of Elm Street
Second Avenue	West	From Park Avenue to Elm Street

If any section, subsection, part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
