

POLICE OFFICER

Westwood Police Department will be accepting applications for full time police officer.

Applicants must be fully trained with a Class "A" basic police officer certification from the New Jersey Police Training Commission; or who have completed and graduated the Alternate Route program from one of the 11 Commission Approved schools; or a waiver eligible, New Jersey Special Class II.

Additional requirements are as follows:

All Applicants must:

- Possess a New Jersey Police Training Commission(PTC) certificate for full-time Municipal police officers; or
- Possess a New Jersey Special Class II certification (certification must be valid as of 10/17/16); or
- Possess a certificate as an Alternate Route graduate from one of the 11 Commission approved schools within the State of New Jersey.
- Be a citizen of the United States and a resident of New Jersey
- Be at least eighteen (18) years of age
- Possess a valid New Jersey driver license
- Possess at a minimum an Associates degree, or equivalent in college credits (64) from an accredited college or university.
- In lieu of the educational requirement possess veteran's status and has been honorably discharged from the armed services.
- Have good moral character and not been convicted of a criminal offense involving moral turpitude;
- Be psychologically and physically fit to perform all the duties of a Police Officer;
- Be able to read and write the English language conversantly.
