
The Borough of Westwood with the authorization of the Bergen County Board of Taxation and the New Jersey Division of Taxation will be undertaking an annual Reassessment Program beginning with the tax year 2017 and continuing through 2021. This program will ensure uniform and equitable assessments throughout the municipality, account for recent changes in the real estate market and significantly reduce the costly tax appeals experienced in the past. The Borough has contracted with Appraisal Systems Inc to assist in conducting the Reassessment Program.

The Reassessment process has begun and will be completed by October, 2016. To keep the residents and taxpayers informed about the process and answer questions regarding the Reassessment a Public Meeting will be held on the following date and time:
