REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration begins on Monday, January 5, 2015, at 9:00 am on a first-come, first-served basis either on-line at www.westwoodnj.gov or at the Recreation Department. Payment may be made in the form of cash, check, or money order payable to: "Borough of Westwood"
NON-RESIDENTS: Non-Residents may register starting on Monday, January 12th if openings are available for an additional \$25.00.
REFUNDS: If you are not 100% satisfied with any of our programs, you will be issued a full refund.
CLOSINGS: Most Recreation Programs are NOT held on Borough Holidays or when the Westwood School System is closed.
INSURANCE: Medical accident coverage is provided as a secondary insurance. If you do not have other insurance, this policy becomes the primary insurer (maximum \$10,000).
CANCELLED PROGRAMS: The Recreation Dept. reserves the right to cancel or alter any program due to insufficient registration or any other logistical reason. Full refunds are given for cancelled programs.
BOROUGH HOLIDAYS: The Recreation Department will be closed on the following dates: Thursday, January 1st (New Years Day), Monday, January 19th (MLK Day), Monday, February 16th (President's Day) and Friday, April 3rd (Good Friday).

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS



All classes are for 15 weeks and are held at the Community Center unless noted.



ABRAKADOODLE ART - Mother Goose and ME! Children will design a new masterpiece each week inspired by this classic such as glittery twinkle stars. Ages 4-6, 3:30-4:15pm; **Art of Sculptures** -Join us as we make cool & fascinating sculptures using clay, plastic, wire, tape, wood & more to create shoes, architectural buildings & more. Grades 1-4 4:30-5:30pm. Classes will be held on Tuesdays, starting January 20th for **8 weeks**. **Fee: \$135** (includes materials)

AFTERSCHOOL KIDS CLUB - Children in grades 4-5 are welcome to participate in activities such as basketball, air hockey, foosball, kick ball, etc. on Fridays from 3:30-5:00pm, beginning January 23rd and ending March 20th. There is no charge for this program, however parents need to fill out a registration form. Supervision will be provided by Recreation staff.

BALLET/TAP 1- Our pre-schoolers at this age experience an intro to ballet and tap. These classes are designed to enhance the coordination and creative ability in a child. Ages 3-4 on Mondays from 2:45- 3:30pm beginning January 26th **Fee: \$115.00**

BALLET/TAP 2- This class expands and enhances the children's' concept and abilities of the basic techniques of ballet, jazz, and tap using a fun and positive method. Ages 5-6 on Mondays from 3:35- 4:20pm beginning January 26th **Fee: \$115.00**

KIDDIE HOP- This intro to Hip Hop is a fun & cool class where your child will learn the fundamentals of this dance style that includes wave movements & rhythmic perception. Grades 1-2 on Mondays from 4:25- 5:10pm beginning January 26th **Fee: \$115.00**

HIP HOP DANCE - This class is all about getting your groove on! Learn such techniques as popping, locking, waving, breaking & more through upbeat rhythms, arm movements & footwork. Grades 3-6 on Mondays, 5:15-6:00pm beginning Jan. 26th **Fee: \$115.00**

CRAFTY KITCHEN - Utilizing seasonal and multicultural themes, students will prepare recipes and create crafts that highlight various skills according to each age group. All classes will be held on Thursday's beginning January 22nd for **8 weeks** Ages 3-5 (with parent) 1-2pm, Grades K-2, 3:45-5pm, Grades 3-5, 5-6:15pm and Fridays, beginning January 23rd for Grades 6-8 from 5:30-7pm **Fee: \$120.00**

GLEE KIDS - If your child has a flair for the dramatic, then this class is for them! Inspired by the hit TV Show Glee, boys and girls will learn singing and dancing technique and work on staged numbers. Classes will be held on Mondays beginning on January 19th from 6:00-7:00pm for children in grades 3-6. There will be a performance at the end of the session **Fee: \$115.00**

MOMMY/DADDY & ME- This program will incorporate music, fitness, games, stories, and crafts for children while allowing positive interaction between adults. Classes will be held on Thursdays beginning January 22nd with limited enrollment; ages 18-23 months: 9:15-10:15, 24-36 months: 10:30-11:30am. Children must be accompanied by an adult. **Fee: \$115.00**
