WHEREAS a major and severe weather storm, commonly referred to as Hurricane Sandy, is expected to bring record amounts of rainfall and high winds causing significant flooding in the Borough of Westwood; and


WHEREAS Chris Christie, Governor of the State of New Jersey, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the people of the State of New Jersey has declared and proclaimed that a State of Emergency presently exists throughout the State of New Jersey; and


WHEREAS Governor Christie has issued Executive Order No. 104 which authorizes and empowers the executive head of any agency or instrumentally of the State government with authority to promulgate rules to waive, suspend or modify any existing rule, the enforcement of which would be detrimental to the public welfare during this emergency, notwithstanding the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act or any law to the contrary for the duration of this Executive Order;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John Birkner, Jr., Mayor of the Borough of Westwood, New Jersey, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of this municipality DO DECLARE, PROCLAIM, ORDER AND DIRECT the following:

1. A State of Emergency hereby exists in the Borough of Westwood effective October 29, 2012 at 12:00 pm.
2. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect at least through Wednesday, October 31, at 12:00 pm, or longer if necessary.
