**Ordinance #20-9**

**An Ordinance to Amend Chapter 375 Vehicles and Traffic To Codify Traffic and Parking Changes In The Area Of Westwood Regional Middle School**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Westwood that Chapter 375 Vehicles and Traffic, be amended as follows (deleted sections are noted by strikethroughs, new sections are **bold and underlined**):

Section 1. Amend:

PART 2 PARKING  
ARTICLE V PARKING PROHIBITIONS

§ 375-28 Restricted parking on school days.

The streets or parts of streets described below are hereby designated as school dropoff and pickup zones. No vehicles may discharge passengers, be parked, standing or left unattended during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., Monday through Friday, when school is in session on the east side location, except for the dropoff zone. Vehicles may park during the hours of 2:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, when school is in session on the east and west side locations (pickup zone) **unless otherwise noted**.

Street	Side	Location
<b><u>Third Avenue</u></b>	<b><u>East</u></b>	<b><u>From a point 75 feet north of the northerly curbline of the WRMS parking lot exit, north for a distance of 100 feet and allowing for 75 feet of integrating lane before the existing crosswalk on Third Avenue. Morning drop zone only. No Parking or standing as per § 375-11 through § 375-13.</u></b>

Section 2. Amend:

PART 2 PARKING  
ARTICLE VII NONMETERED TIME LIMIT PARKING

§ 375-30 Three-hour zones.

No person shall park a vehicle for longer than three hours at any time between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on any day, except Sundays and public holidays, unless otherwise designated below, upon any of the streets or parts of streets described below:

Street	Side	Location
<b><u>Pine Street</u></b>	<b><u>South</u></b>	<b><u>Entire length</u></b>

Section 3. Amend:

PART 3 TRAFFIC

ARTICLE XIII ENTRANCE AND EXITS TO PUBLIC PARKING LOTS AND PARKING YARDS

§ 375-51 Designation of entrances and exits.

Pursuant to the authority granted to this municipality under N.J.S.A. 39:4-197h, the Governing Body of the Borough of Westwood finds it in the interest of the public safety and for the proper regulation of traffic to regulate the entrances and exits to parking lots and parking yards which are open to the public or to which the public is invited. The following described entrances and exits are hereby designated for ingress and egress in the directions indicated. No person shall enter or exit in a manner other than described.

Street	Location
<u><b>Third Avenue</b></u>	<u><b>For the property of No. 23, WRMS parking lot, there shall be no left turn from the exit onto Third Avenue (right turn only) school days 7:30 am to 9:00 am and 2:30 pm to 4:30 pm.</b></u>

Section 4. Amend:

ARTICLE XVI TURN RESTRICTIONS

§ 375-61 Turns prohibited during certain hours.

No driver or operator of any motor vehicle shall make a turn as described below on any day, during the times designated, at the following locations:

Street	Direction	Prohibited Turn/Hours
<u><b>Pine Street</b></u>	<u><b>East</b></u>	<u><b>No left turn onto Third Avenue North during the hours of 7:30 am to 9:00 am and 2:30 pm to 4:30 pm</b></u>
<u><b>Third Avenue</b></u>	<u><b>South</b></u>	<u><b>No left turn into the WRMS Main School Parking Lot, school days only</b></u>

Section 5. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or any other part of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 7. If any section, subsection, part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
