Ordinance #19-11

An Ordinance to Amend Chapter 375 Vehicles and Traffic To Codify Traffic and Parking Changes In The Area Of Berkeley School

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Westwood that Chapter 375 Vehicles and Traffic, be amended as follows (deleted sections are noted by strikethroughs, new sections are **bold and underlined**):

PART 2 PARKING

ARTICLE V PARKING PROHIBITIONS

Section 1. Amend

§ 375-13 Parking prohibited at all times.

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts of streets described below:

Street	Side	Location
Berkeley Avenue	East	From the southerly curbline of Harrington Avenue, south for a distance of 392 <u>feet except as designated in § 375-28</u>
<u>Berkeley Avenue</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>From the southerly curbline of Harrington Avenue, south for a distance of 386 feet, except as designated in § 375-28</u>
<u>Harrington Avenue</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>From the easterly curbline of Berkeley Avenue, east for a distance of 360 feet</u>
<u>Harrington Avenue</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>From the easterly curbline of Berkeley Avenue east for a distance of 365 feet except as designated in § 375-28</u>

ARTICLE VI RESTRICTED PARKING

Section 2. Amend

§ 375-28 (~~Reserved~~) **Restricted parking on school days**

The streets or parts of streets described below are hereby designated as school drop off and pick up zones. No vehicles may discharge passengers, be parked, standing or or left unattended during the hours of 7:30 am to 9:30 am, Monday through Friday, when school is in session on the east side location, except for the (drop off zone). Vehicles may park during the hours of 2:30 pm to 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday, when school is in session

on the east and west side locations (pickup zone).

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
<u>Berkeley Avenue</u>	<u>East</u>	<u>from the southerly curb line of Harrington Avenue, south for a distance of 392 feet.</u>
<u>Berkeley Avenue</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>from the southerly curb line of Harrington Avenue, south for a distance of 386 feet, designated as a 5-minute parking during the above drop off hours</u>
<u>Harrington Avenue</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>from the easterly curb line of Berkeley Avenue east for a distance of 365 feet except during the hours of 7:30 am to 9:30 am and 2:30 pm to 4:30 pm school days only for (school pickup and drop off)</u>

Section 3. Amend

§ 375-30 Three Hour Zones

No person shall park a vehicle for longer than three hours at any time between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on any day, except Sundays and public holidays, **unless otherwise designated below**, upon any of the streets or parts of streets described below:

<u>Berkeley Avenue</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>East</u>	<u>From a point 392 feet south of the southerly curbline of Harrington Avenue, south to Lowell Street</u>
<u>(school days, 9:30 am to 2:30 pm)</u>			
<u>Berkeley Avenue</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>From the southerly curbline of Harrington Avenue, south to Lowell Street <u>From a point 386 feet south of the southerly curbline of Harrington Avenue South to Lowell Street</u></u>
<u>(school days, 9:30 am to 2:30 pm)</u>			
<u>Berkeley Avenue</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>From a point 128 feet north of the northerly curbline line of Harrington Avenue for 230 feet to Bogert Place</u>
<u>(school days, 9:30 am to 2:30 pm)</u>			
<u>Berkeley Avenue</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>East</u>	<u>From a point 46 feet north of the northerly curb line of Harrington Avenue for 345 feet north to Bogert Place</u>
<u>(school days, 9:30 am to 2:30 pm)</u>			
<u>Lexington Avenue</u>		<u>East</u>	<u>From Harrington Avenue, south to Old Hook Road <u>to Lowell Street</u></u>
<u>Lexington Avenue</u>		<u>West</u>	<u>From Harrington Avenue, south to Old Hook Road <u>to Lowell Street</u></u>

ARTICLE VIIIA EMPLOYEE PARKING

Section 4. New

§ 375-46.4 Designated School Employee Parking Zone

A. The following locations are hereby designated a school employee parking zone. No person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 6:00 am and 4:00 pm on school days unless the vehicle has displayed from its rear view mirror a valid and current employee parking hang tag.

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
<u>Westvale Park</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>Parking stalls in the most westerly portion of the lot, parallel to Sand Road</u>

Sand Road

East

From a point 128 feet south of the westerly curb line of Harrington Avenue for a distance of 210 feet south.

§ 375-46.5 Violations and penalties

PART 3 TRAFFIC
ARTICLE XII ONE WAY STREETS

Section 6. Amend

§ 375-50 Designation of one-way streets.

The following described streets or parts of streets are hereby designated as one-way streets in the direction indicated:

Street	Direction	Location
<u>Berkeley Avenue</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>Starting at Harrington Avenue and continuing onto Lowell Street, ending at the intersection of Lexington Avenue</u>

Elm Street	East	Between Second Avenue and First Avenue

Section 7. Amend

§ 375-60 Turns prohibited at all times.

No driver or operator of any motor vehicle shall make a turn as described below at any time at the following locations:

Street	Direction	Prohibited turns
<u>Harrington Avenue</u>	<u>East</u>	<u>No left turn out of the exit of Berkeley School employee parking lot.</u>

PART 5 SCHOOL CROSSINGS
Article XXIII Designation of School Crossings

§ 375-90 Designation of School Crossings

In accordance with and pursuant to the authority of P.L. 1999, c. 185, the following is a list of school crossings which have been so designated by the Borough of Westwood:

- A) **Third Avenue and Pine Street**
- B) **Third Avenue and Mill Street**
- C) **Mill Street and Clairmont Avenue**
- D) **Clairmont Avenue and Westend**
- E) **Lake Drive and Forest Avenue**
- F) **Ridgewood Avenue and Lafayette Avenue**
- G) **Elm Street and First Avenue**
- H) **Kinderkamack Road and Westwood Avenue**
- I) **Harrington Avenue and Berkeley Avenue**
- J) **Sand Road and Pascack Road**

Section 9. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or any other part of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 10. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 11. If any section, subsection, part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 12. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
