ORDINANCE NO. 12- 23

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE XIX SIGN
REGULATIONS TO INCLUDE TEMPORARY SIGNS IN
HOSPITAL ZONE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Westwood that Article XIX, Sign Regulations, of the Borough Code shall be amended as follows:

A new section numbered 195-155(c) entitled “Temporary Signs in Hospital Zone” shall be added and shall read as follows:

A. Temporary signs promoting healthcare or wellness of any size shall be permitted in the H-Hospital Zone subject to the following limitations:

- i. The sign shall be displayed for a maximum of 120 days;
- ii. Any such sign greater than 4 feet by 8 feet shall be attached to the principal building on the property;
- iii. Signs of 32 square feet or less may be displayed at any locations on the property other than the public right of way or a location which obstructs a sight triangle. Such signs shall not exceed one (1) sign per five (5) acres;
- iv. Building mounted signs shall be permitted without regard to size provided they do not extend above the parapet, obstruct the windows of any rooms occupied by a patient or create any type of hazard.

If any section, subsection, part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
