

Councilman Peter Grefrath grew up in nearby Paramus before moving to Westwood in 1984 with his wife, Noeline, a teacher in the Westwood Regional school system. Originally appointed to the Westwood Borough Council in 1995, **Councilman Grefrath** is currently the liaison for Health and Recreation. From 1997 until 2006, he served as Fire Department Commissioner and liaison to the Volunteer Ambulance Corps, and he also spent two years as Land Use Liaison. For the past four years, he served as Liaison of Administration and Capital Projects as he did in 1995. **Grefrath** was elected by his colleagues on the Council to be Council President from 2001 to 2003 and again in 2006.

A former liaison to the Shade Tree Advisory Committee and the Parking Authority and deputy liaison for Police, **Grefrath** is currently also liaison to the Borough's Board of Health, Recreation Board, and Heritage Society. He served on the September 11 Memorial Committee, has been the secretary to and a member of the Local Assessment Committee, and was a member of the Planning Board for several years.

The father of two daughters, Elizabeth and Victoria, **Grefrath** has always been very involved in local community activities. He coached Westwood girls basketball and is a member of the Westwood Republican Organization, having served as both President and Treasurer. He also is co-founder and chairman of the annual Westwood Charity Golf Outing which has raised approximately \$85,000 for local groups over the past 15 years.

Grefrath has a BS degree in Journalism from the University of Maryland and an MBA in Management from Fairleigh Dickinson University. Employed by Trust Company of the West, he is a Vice President in the company's Marketing and Communications groups. He also is an adjunct professor at Fairleigh Dickinson University, teaching "Organizational Behavior and Leadership" in the school's MBA Program.
